A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE MISSION HILLS COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT APPROVING COST OF LIVING ADJUSTMENTS FOR ALL PERMANENT DISTRICT EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, the Mission Hills Community Services District (the "District") is formed pursuant to California Government Code Section 61000 et seq.;

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Government Code Section 61241 and Section 61244, the District Board of Directors ("Board") may fix compensation of District employees;

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2017 the Board approved the District's Budget (the "Budget") for fiscal year 2018/2019 which included a new pay schedule that incorporated an across the board one and a half percent (2.5%) cost of living adjustment for all permanent District employees; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that it is in the best interests of the District and the community, to adjust employee compensation consistent with the District's Budget and the cost of living in the area.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Mission Hills Community Services District hereby approves a one and a half percent (2.5%) cost of living increase to all District employees' compensation. This Resolution shall become effective the 1st of July 2018.
